Rochester vs. Milwaukee Sunday, August 17, 1997

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Rochester Rhinos (11-12) snapped their eight-game losing streak on Friday night behind GK Billy Andracki's fifth shutout of the season en route to a 1-0 victory over Charleston ... The win was their sixth at Frontier Field and their second over the Battery ... Rochester has five regular season games remaining in 1997 and two are against teams they are trying to catch in the Northeast Division ... Milwaukee (12-11), currently second in the Central Division, is fighting off three other clubs for home-field advantage; the Rampage are just one point ahead of Nashville (15-10), two in front of Orlando (10-15) and four ahead of Minnesota (10-12) ... Milwaukee brings a four-game winning streak to Frontier Field and they have won six of their last seven matches ...

RHINOS CLINCH PLAYOFF BERTH WITH WIN: Despite their eight-game losing streak, the Rhinos are still in position to clinch a playoff spot with a regulation win this evening, thanks in large part to the outstanding 10-4 mark they posted to start the season ... The win would give Rochester 36 points, surpassing the maximum 34 Connecticut could total by winning their last four matches ... After clinching a playoff berth, the Rhinos will set their sights on second place and home-field advantage in the first round of the playoffs ...

ROAD WARRIORS: Milwaukee plays their 14th and final road game of the season tonight, having recorded a 7-6 mark thus far; they enter the game with road wins in three of their last four contests ... The seven road wins represent the fifth most in the A-League ... Of Milwaukee's six road losses, four have been by shutout ... The Rampage was 8-4 on the road last season

GLENN'S A GAMER: In just his first season as a Rhino, F Jimmy Glenn is making a name for himself in the franchise record books ... Glenn's eleven goals is the third highest total in team history, behind fellow F Doug Miller's top two marks (18 in 1996, 15 in 1997) ... His six assists is tied for the second highest total ever with M Tommy Tanner's six last season; both trail the team record of seven set by M Hector Marinaro in 1996 ... Of the Rhinos last eight goals, four have come from Jimmy Glenn ...

NEWCOMERS HIT THE TURF: The three newest Rhinos all saw action on Friday -- D Mali Walton played 90 minutes at the sweeper position and controlled the defense very well; D Justin Stoddard and M Nate Daligcon were late second half subs and provided fresh legs, helping the Rhinos seal the victory ... Daligcon became the 28th player to suit up for the Rhinos this season, surpassing last season's total of 27.
