**ROCHESTER RHINOS**  
VS LONG ISLAND ROUGH RIDERS



**TONIGHT'S MATCH:** THE ROCHESTER RAGING RHINOS (17-2, 49 POINTS) HOST A TEAM TONIGHT THAT - NO MATTER WHAT THE OUTCOME OF A MATCH - ALWAYS FINDS A WAY TO SPOIL THE RHINOS' PARTY... THE LONG ISLAND ROUGH RIDERS (10-8, 26 POINTS) MOSEY INTO FRONTIER FIELD FOR THEIR SECOND VISIT OF THE SEASON. BACK ON JUNE 5, THE RHINOS WERE ABLE TO RIDE BEHIND FORWARD DARREN TILLEY, WHOSE GOAL IN THE 26TH MINUTE BROKE A 1-1 TIE AND PROVED TO BE OFFENSE ENOUGH FOR A ROCHESTER VICTORY... DESPITE THE LOSS, THE ROUGH RIDERS WERE ABLE TO PUT AN END TO THE RHINOS' SIX-GAME CONSECUTIVE SHUTOUT STREAK, AND RIDER FERNANDO FERNANDES (1+1=3) WAS THE FIRST PLAYER TO SCORE ON 'KEEPER PAT ONSTAD (16-2, 0.43 GAA) AFTER A SPAN OF 581 SHUTOUT MINUTES... THE TWO TEAMS MET AGAIN ON JUNE 29 AT HOFSTRA STADIUM, AND THE ROUGH RIDERS ESCAPED WITH A SHOOTOUT VICTORY AND THE SATISFACTION OF BECOMING THE FIRST TEAM TO DEFEAT THE UNDEFEATED RHINOS IN 1998... SO TONIGHT'S THE 1998 RUBBER MATCH, AND BOTH ROCHESTER AND LONG ISLAND ENTER HAVING WON TWO IN A ROW...

**TILLEY ON A TEAR:** RHINOS FORWARD DARREN TILLEY (9+5=23) HAS BEEN SELECTED AS THE JERRY'S JEWELER'S RHINOS PLAYER OF THE MONTH FOR JULY 1998... TILLEY LEADS THE RHINOS IN SCORING AND ALSO HAS A TEAM-HIGH FIVE-GAME POINTS STREAK DURING WHICH HE HAS SCORED SIX GOALS AND COLLECTED THREE ASSISTS (6+3=15)... TWO OF THOSE GOALS WERE GAME-WINNERS: JULY 12 AGAINST THE STATEN ISLAND VIPERS AND JULY 25 AGAINST THE MONTREAL IMPACT... THE 6'3" KEYNSHAM, ENGLAND NATIVE SCORED ROCHESTER'S ONLY GOAL IN THE JULY 7 U.S. OPEN CUP TOURNAMENT LOSS TO MAJOR LEAGUE SOCCER'S COLUMBUS CREW AND COLLECTED AN ASSIST IN THE JULY 15 METROSTARS (MLS) FRIENDLY... HE NOW RANKS SEVENTH IN THE A-LEAGUE IN SCORING...

**LANCER-MANIA:** THE ROCHESTER LANCERS ALUMNI WILL TAKE ON THE "STARS OF ITALIAN SOCCER" TONIGHT AT 6:15 P.M... RHINOS ASSISTANT COACH FRANK ODOI AND RHINOS COLOR COMMENTATOR DON LALKA WILL LEAD THE LANCERS ALUMNI, A ROSTER THAT ALSO FEATURES OTHER STARS FROM YESTERYEAR LIKE CARLOS METIDIERI AND MIKE STOJANOVIC... THE ITALIAN TEAM IS COMPRISED OF FORMER PLAYERS FROM THE 1982 WORLD CUP CHAMPION ITALIAN NATIONAL TEAM AND FORMER MEMBERS OF JUVENTUS, A POWERHOUSE CLUB FROM THE ITALIAN PREMIER LEAGUE...

**RHINOS RAMBLINGS:** THE RHINOS HAVE NEARLY TWO WEEKS OFF FROM THEIR A-LEAGUE SCHEDULE AFTER TONIGHT. ROCHESTER'S NEXT A-LEAGUE MATCH IS FRIDAY, AUGUST 14 AT FRONTIER FIELD AGAINST THE HAMPTON ROADS MARINERS (10-6, 28 POINTS)... THE RHINOS WILL, HOWEVER, SEE SOME COMPETITION BETWEEN THE LONG ISLAND AND HAMPTON ROADS MATCHES. THE FIRST ANNUAL "CAN-AM CUP" EXHIBITION BETWEEN THE RHINOS AND MONTREAL IMPACT WILL BE HELD ON FRIDAY, AUGUST 7 AT 7:30 P.M. AT CLAUDE-ROBILLARD STADIUM IN MONTREAL... ROCHESTER IS UNDEFEATED IN 1998 AGAINST A-LEAGUE OPPONENTS AT FRONTIER FIELD (10-0). TEN WINS IS A NEW FRANCHISE HIGH FOR HOME VICTORIES... FORWARD DOUG MILLER (HAMSTRING) AND MIDFIELDER TOMMY TANNER (HAMSTRING) ARE BOTH DOUBTFUL TONIGHT... LONG ISLAND'S FOUR-TIME ALL-STAR TRAVIS RINKER (2+0=4) WILL MISS TONIGHT'S MATCH WITH A RED CARD SUSPENSION... WITH A GOAL IN THURSDAY NIGHT'S 1-0 WIN OVER HERSHEY, JIMMY GLENN (7+4=18) BECAME ONLY THE SECOND RHINO IN FRANCHISE HISTORY TO HAVE SCORED 20 REGULAR-SEASON GOALS... TONIGHT'S KICK-OFF IS SCHEDULED FOR 7:35 P.M.

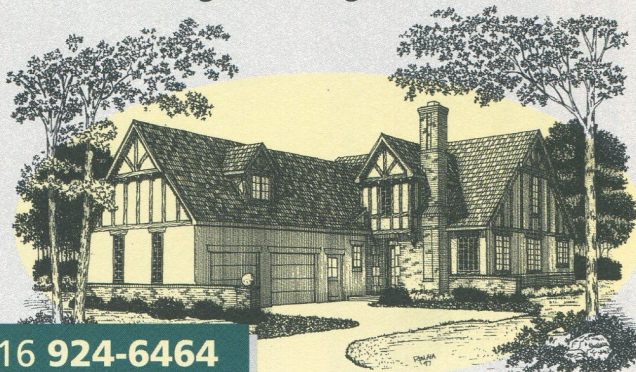
